## HUNTING FOR A WORLD SERIES BID

Huntingburg, Indiana has been named the host city for the 2010 Great Lakes Regional Tournament. [Huntingburg League Stadium](#) (HLS) located in Dubois County, will be the host field from May 14<sup>th</sup> through the 16<sup>th</sup>. This marks the 5<sup>th</sup> year the Tournament has been hosted by Huntingburg. HLS was built in the late 1800's with major renovations in 1894 and 1991. The stadium renovations in '91 were due to the filming of the movie, "A League of their Own" starring Tom Hanks, Geena Davis, and Madonna. HLS was upgraded and made into the home field of the Rockford Peaches, with a seating capacity over 2,700. The stadium is now home to the Dubois County Bombers of the Central Illinois Collegiate League and IHSAA Sectional and Regional Baseball Tournaments.

Dubois County is home to Indiana's [Baseball Hall of Fame](#) and other area attractions including [Patoka Lake](#), [Fuzzy's Miniature Golf and Go Karts](#), and famous [Schnitzelbank Restaurant](#). If you are looking to drive a bit further some nearby attractions include [Holiday World & Splashin' Safari](#) in Santa Claus, [West Baden Springs](#), [Wyandotte Woods & Caves Complex](#) in Corydon and several [wineries](#). Already Dubois County has shown a huge interest in promoting the GLR Tournament and word of this baseball event is sure to spread quickly through the smaller towns of Jasper and Huntingburg.

Accommodations in Huntingburg are top notch as well and only 5 minutes from the stadium. Any team staying overnight will find the host hotel, [Quality Inn](#), to fill all of their needs at the outstanding rate of **\$54.99** per night. All of the rooms feature microwave/refrigerator combos, 25 inch TV's with full cable including HBO, and high speed internet access is available at no cost. In addition players will have access to the free expanded continental breakfast bar, fitness center, and outdoor pool. To make reservations, please call **(812) 683-2334** and state you are with the **NCBA**.

Los Dos Charros at the Quality Inn will once again host the Friday team night where conference trophies will be presented. This event will begin at 6 PM and players, families, and fans will receive a 10% discount on their meal purchase. Grandy's Restaurant located at 1205 N. Main Street will host a Saturday team night where the All-Region award winners will be announced. This event will begin at 6 PM and players, families, and fans will receive a 10% discount on their meal purchase. In addition Subway on Main Street will be sponsoring the Great Lakes tournament. All players will be provided a VIP card and receive 10% off their purchase at Subway.

Fans and players will be able to purchase game day programs and tournament T-shirts at the press box. The NCBA will be providing DakStats coverage on the [clubbaseball.org](#) website for all of those fans who are unable to attend. Eric Marquardt from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee will be volunteering as the P.A. Announcer and scoreboard operator throughout the tournament.

The 2010 Tournament features some familiar faces with the University of Wisconsin and Central Michigan University earning a bid after a one year hiatus. Miami University is making its second straight appearance at the tournament while The University of Illinois is making its 6<sup>th</sup> consecutive appearance. With the schedule set, this year's Great Lakes Tournament is shaping up to be one of the best ever!

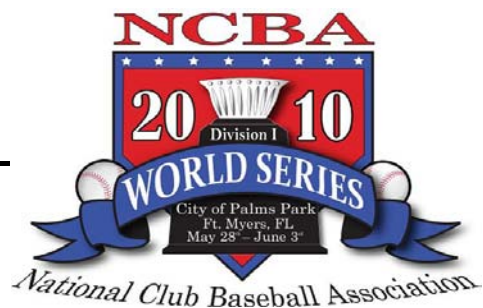
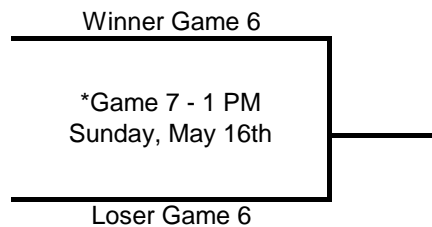
